## Special Offer for Dental Crown \$900 and Single Implant Fully Restored \$3500

### Terms & Conditions

1. You must attend a complimentary consultation prior to us agreeing to treat you.
2. It is at the discretion of the dentist to refuse treatment under this special offer, based on factors including but not limited to patient expectations differing from realistic clinically possible outcomes, patient's inability due to anxiety, gagging reflex or other clinical limitations, to undergo treatment at the dentist providing the treatment, position in the mouth and medical and dental conditions. This is not a judgement based on whether an implant or crown can be placed or not, rather whether the dentist is able to perform the treatment for the special offer price, given that increased complications in the treatment will require more clinical time and material expense, thus increasing cost.
3. The tooth to be crowned must be ready for crown placement, being decay free, free of infection, and with a suitable core filling if applicable. If in doubt, consult a dentist.
4. Patient requiring an implant must have a Cone Beam CT image taken at the patient's own expense, to assess the jaw anatomy prior to agreeing to place an implant under this special price. The same Cone Beam CT will need to be used for implant planning and placement.
5. The area for implant placement must be ready for implant placement, this being a space where a tooth is missing. If a tooth is still in place, an implant cannot be in this space. Patients will need to investigate their options of treatment and possible removal of the tooth and subsequent implant placement at a dentist of their choice. PLEASE NOTE: IF A TOOTH IS STILL IN PLACE, CONSULT EITHER GREENWOOD DENTAL OR A DENTIST OF YOUR CHOICE PRIOR TO HAVING THE TOOTH REMOVED, IF YOU WISH TO HAVE THE OPTION OF IMPLANT PLACEMENT. SPECIAL MANAGEMENT NEEDS TO BE TAKEN WHEN REMOVING A TOOTH, IF YOU PLAN TO HAVE AN IMPLANT PLACED. TOOTH REMOVAL AND ANY BONE PRESERVATION/AUGMENTATION IS AT THE PATIENT'S OWN EXPENSE.

6. Patient's cannot specify the materials to be used during the treatment. It is at the dentist's discretion what materials are to be used under the special offer. Patient's may request alternatives, but this would incur extra cost.
7. Patient's must read, demonstrate their understanding, and accept all points listed on the consent form for their particular treatment. Patient's must also sign the consent form prior to any treatment being performed. The process of Informed Consent will be done after the initial consultation if the patient is found suitable for the special offer.
8. Patient's must agree to the financial consent form prior to any treatment being performed.
9. "Crown" means single tooth crown only, and not to be incorporated into any other restoration, such as a bridge.
10. Bone augmentation or periodontal surgery for crown lengthening if required, are not covered under the special offer.
11. Payment option include, Cash, Bank Transfer, or Credit Card through PayPalMe.
12. A non-refundable fee is required to confirm bookings for implants or crowns. This is to cover the cost of supplies specific to each individual which cannot be used for other patients, and to cover operational costs in the event a patient cancels their appointment within 1 week of their appointment time, or does not show for their appointment. Patient's may cancel or reschedule their appointment any time before 1 week of their appointment. The deposit is \$400 per crown, and \$1250
13. Dental Crowns are generally completed in 1 visit, using the CEREC chairside CAD/CAM system, unless otherwise deemed necessary by the dentist. Although CEREC crowns are excellent, they may not meet the aesthetic requirements for front teeth, especially if a close colour match is required. Alternative crowns can be offered, but this would incur an extra cost of \$300 per crown to cover laboratory costs and additional clinical time.
14. Restored dental implants require multiple dental visits, which can span over 2-6 months, depending on healing. Generally, the titanium dental implant is placed in one appointment, followed by a period of healing. The restoration (Tooth) on the implant is placed 2-4 months later. During this time, there is no tooth in place. A retainer may be required to maintain the space for the tooth during this time. If a patient wishes to have a temporary tooth in place for aesthetics, this will be at their own additional expense.
